## The Meeting

The meeting began at 6:07 pm – pizza and beverages were provided.

**President:** Aaron Zick Began the meeting with approval of the January minutes.

## Unfinished Business

Chris Underwood says Doug will let the SCMC have a spot in the display case above the range ball machine for an advertisement. He created a preliminary flyer (see sheet 4) for the board to look at. He will print it and have it put in the case. He also says Doug did not want us to put an A-frame style sign on the course.

Scott Carver distributed an updated version of the Title Sponsorship set-up (see sheet 5).

The membership survey was tabled until the next meeting.

## New Business

- 1) Dave Sanders made a motion to change the Bylaws from “Handicap Director” to “Handicap Chairman”. Mike Sly seconded the motion and a vote was held and the motion passed unanimously.
- 2) Scott Carver had previously sent out a proposal for major tournament title sponsorships (see page 4). He made a motion to approve the proposal with the following changes: Non-member price: \$1000 sponsorships for 1-day tournaments and \$1500 for 2-day tournaments.  
The motion was seconded and a vote was held. The motion was passed unanimously.
- 3) There was a short discussion about conducting board meetings via Teams or Zoom. It was agreed that option is not preferable to live meetings.

## Upcoming Events:

### **The US Open (June 20th):**

The following are the set-up and rules Randahl has submitted for the US Open:

- 1) Stroke Play – Gross and Net with a \$40 entry fee (includes Gross & Net and Skins).
- 2) 3 Tees – Blue, White and White/Gold combo.
- 3) Players will choose the Tees they want to play at sign-up.
- 4) Players can choose 1 other player in their group.
- 5) The payout will be a 30-70 split for gross and net paying 33% of the field.
- 6) 9:30 am rolling tee times.
- 7) \$600 additional prize added by SCMC

## Officer Reports

**President:** Aaron Zick reports that Randahl plans not attend any more board meetings but will continue in his role as Tournament Director. He will email all future tournament proposals to the board prior to board meetings.

**Vice President:** Chris Underwood did not have anything to report.

**Treasurer:** Scott Carver had several items to report:

- 1) He will email the current budget to the board.
- 2) He has paid the \$466 invoice for the Directors & Operators insurance premium.
- 3) The OGA sends invoices on a monthly basis. This month it was \$1146.
- 4) He allocated \$600 for the prize fund for the Member – Member/Guest

**Tournament Director:**

- 1) Randahl emailed the board the set-up for the US Open (see upcoming events).
- 2) He will send the sign-up email out today.

**Handicap Chairman:**

- 1) Dave Sanders reported that we currently have 321 members signed up. 214 of those signed up using Member Planet and 107 signed up the traditional way.
- 2) He has inquired with the OGA about setting up the member survey and should have an answer in the next week.

**Secretary:** Mike Rusch did not have anything to report.

**At Large Member:** Kieth Rist reports he has some questions from members about the match play schedules.

**At Large Member:** Mike Sly did not have anything to report because he was absent.

## Committee Reports

**Tournament Committee:**

- 1) Turnout for the Masters was somewhat low, most likely due to the 2pm starting time.
- 2) Randahl will send the set up for the US open to the board this week.
- 3) Randahl will send the sign-up email for the Member-Member/Guest on Tuesday.
- 4) If there are less than 10 players signed up for the white/gold tees for majors in the future what should the protocol be:
  - A) Ask the players if they want to move to the white flight or if they would prefer to withdraw.
  - B) Have the group/groups play white/gold for net only.
  - C) Have group/groups play in the white flight appropriate for their handicap.

**Handicap Committee:** No report.
