TREASURER REPORT:

HANDICAP COMMITTEE REPORT:

Announced we currently have 342 paid members with approximately 25% of those being new members.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE REPORT:

Discussed the items mentioned in the Apr. email sent to the Board. The following comments are highlights of those that were discussed. Happy with the Sat. game turnout recently (36 members for a couple of weeks). Sun. May 8 will be the Sat. game that week as there is a tournament scheduled for that Sat. There will be no Sat. game on May 28. There will be a Memorial holiday game on Mon. May 30 with details to follow. The match play pods have been finalized with pairings assigned and to be completed by dates listed.

OLD BUSINESS:

A Board member had been asked by a member if his son (early teens) could become a member of the club. The current rules of the club do not show an age limit. Although amateur status would not be affected, the Board felt that maturity of teens could be an issue. Several clubs were researched and found to have age requirements. After discussion, the Board voted to adopt 18 as the minimum age to be eligible for membership.

NEW BUSINESS:

Because the Wed. game members are growing older, it was suggested that a white/gold tee box could be used in addition to the white tee standard. Also, maybe the gold tees alone could be used. The course is being rerated in May and it was decided to wait until afterwards to revisit this topic.

Also suggested was holding a major tournament on a Wed. instead of Sat. (not counting the Super Senior). Since the major schedule has already been established for the year, it was decided to table this discussion until the end of the year.

Pace of play continues to be an issue. There is a policy in place in the Handbook to monitor and discipline slow play if necessary. It involves timeclocks which we have and a scorecard or other facsimile to record the times. This will be hopefully resolved at the next Board meeting.
