STANDING RULES

ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Date: March, 2020

1. Only one signature is required on a Stone Creek Ladies Golf Club check. The President and the Treasurer are authorized to sign alone. Bank statements will be electronically retrieved monthly from the bank by the Treasurer and made available to the President if requested. The Treasurer will share the pass codes to the account with the President.
2. Current USGA Rules of Golf and Stone Creek Ladies Club policy shall be observed in all golf events. These shall be enforced and interpreted by the Competition Chairman or member of her committee.
3. Maximum handicap to be used by any member shall be the USGA handicap index of 38.2. Prospective new members must turn in 3 attested scorecards to establish a temporary handicap in order to meet the required 38.2 index.
4. A two day 36 hole Championship format competition shall be held. Only current members that have played a minimum of five 18 hole rounds in the current season with the Ladies Club shall be eligible for Championship tournament play. The same criteria applies for Most Improved Player.
5. The annual dues shall be determined each season by the Board at their Fall meeting. The OGA handicapping fee will be paid in addition to the dues if an OGA handicapping fee is not paid through another women's club. Stone Creek Ladies Golf Club must have ten OGA paying members to constitute a club.

6. Competitions/special event games must be approved by the Executive Board at least one week prior to the event. Reservations for competitions shall be paid in advance as specified by the Competition Chair. Competitions dates will not be rescheduled. Competition cancellations must be made 7 days ahead in order to get the fee returned. If golfer cancels less than 7 days ahead, no refund can occur. If the cancellee can find a replacement, the new person should pay the cancellee.

7. End of the Year Awards

- **Overall Most Improved Player Award**

This award is determined by improvement in GHIN. A trophy and cash are awarded. To be considered, player must play 5 times with the club during regular play.

- **Overall Low Gross and Low Net from Eclectic Card play Award**

A trophy and cash are awarded. Cash awards are also made in each flight with flights determined by the last GHIN revision in September.

8. Hole-In-One Club

Membership is included in Club. The regular season HIO coincides with the Opening Day through the Closing Day of the Stone Creek Ladies Golf Club. The hole-in-one must be made during a regular day's play at Stone Creek Golf Course or at a rated course on an official scheduled Away Day as set by Day's Play Chair. The winter HIO season will extend from the Closing Day to Opening Day of the regular season, and can be played any day of the week. The game must be played At Stone Creek Golf Course, and must be witnessed by a member of the regular season Stone Creek Ladies Club. Only regular season members of the Ladies Club will be

eligible to participate in the winter HIO game.

The hole-in-one must be the first shot played to the hole and the player must be playing a stipulated round. Regular season payouts will occur after the close of the season and will be awarded at the year-end luncheon. If there is more than one winner, monies will be paid out in equal amounts to all winners. Any unpaid money will be put back into the general fund. Winter HIO payouts are out of a separate budget and will be made at the beginning of the regular season.

LOCAL RULES

1. Heavily sanded areas will be considered Abnormal Ground Conditions. If all fellow players agree, the member will be allowed relief under Rule 25-1. The Day's Play Coordinators will check with the pro shop to determine the condition of the course.
2. Players will be allowed to lift, clean, and place a ball that has settled in a plug hole according to Appendix I, pp. 129, "d."
3. Hole number 6: The water on the left is to be considered red staked and a lateral water hazard. Hole number 14: When "A" green is in use, the hazard on the right of the green will be considered a lateral water hazard. Players are to proceed under Rule 26-1 for relief.
4. When winter rules are in effect, players are allowed to lift, clean, and place their ball within one club length on the fairway and within six inches in the rough.
5. Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green (e.g. a sprinkler head): "Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 24-2 if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes **on the line of play between the ball and the hole**, the player may take relief as follows:

The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted."

DAY'S PLAY RULES AND PROCEDURES

You must sign in with the Day's Play Coordinators and pay your day's play fee (\$3.00) no less than 30 minutes prior to start time. Verify handicap and then mark score card with allocated strokes per hole. **Tardiness may result in forfeiture of your T-time.**

T-times will be set by the Pro Shop throughout the season. They are posted every week by Monday AM in the Stone Creek website.

Questions regarding Winter/Summer Rules should be addressed to the Day's Play Coordinators prior to teeing off. If carts must stay on "cart path only", winter rules are in effect.

Exchange official scorecards within your group and keep an extra for yourself. Any questions on score should be discussed and settled before the next hole.

Money won for the day will be handed out the following Tuesday.

After play, immediately enter your adjusted score hole by hole into the computer, fill out the Eclectic Card, fill out the play day sheet, and turn in score cards to Days Play Coordinators.

Sign up for the following week on the signup sheet provided. If you do not sign up for the following week you must contact the Pro Shop no later than 6pm on Sunday to be added to the list.

Cancellation: if you're signed up but cannot play, contact the Pro Shop as soon as possible to be deleted from the list.

SPEED OF PLAY TIPS

PLAY READY GOLF

Select the club for your next shot on your walk to your ball.

Limit yourself to one or two practice swings.

Scoring partners are responsible for spotting partner's ball!

Pull your cart toward the next hole, and away from the green.

Write the score down when away from the green, so as not to block incoming players.

It is up to all in the foursome to keep play moving.

**KEEP IN MIND THAT YOUR PLACE ON THE GOLF COURSE IS DIRECTLY BEHIND THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU,
NOT DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE GROUP BEHIND YOU.**



SCORECARDS

If you pick up on a hole:

To maintain speed of play, you are encouraged to pick up on any hole where your score reaches the maximum score based on your handicap.

Put an X on scorecard for that hole.

You must post your score with par plus 2 plus allocated handicap strokes for that hole.

You can qualify for pay balls (chip-ins, birdies, eagles) on all other holes but will not be eligible for gross and net pay out for the day's competition.

Legibly complete your score card with:

First initial; Full last name (Ex: B; Smith)

Gross Score

Handicap

Net score

Putts

Circled max score to post.

Verify scores in your group and sign your scorecards.

Make sure your card is signed and attested in order to qualify for possible winnings.

After play:

Fill in Eclectic by circling your improved score for each hole.

Immediately after play post your hole by hole score into the computer. Post adjusted score into the computer "hole by hole". The computer will calculate your adjusted score.

Fill in sheets required for Day's Play. Leave scorecard with Day's Play Coordinators.

Sign up for next week's play.

STONE CREEK LADIES CLUB 2020

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this golf club shall be Stone Creek Ladies Golf Club hereafter called "The Ladies Club."

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

- A. To stimulate interest in golf by bringing together a group of golfers desirous of forming a golfing organization.
- B. To promote and foster among the members a closer fraternity for their joint and mutual benefit, and to promote and conserve the best interests and true spirit of the game of golf as embodied in its ancient and honorable traditions.
- C. To encourage conformation to the USGA Rules of Golf by creating a representative authority.
- D. To maintain a uniform system of handicapping as set forth in the World Handicap System and issue World Handicap Indexes to its members.
- E. To provide a body with authority to govern and conduct club competitions.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all women with a USGA handicap not to exceed 38.2. To meet this standard, a prospective member may establish a temporary handicap by turning in 3 attested scorecards.

ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS

Order of Business

A. At all meetings the order of business shall be as follows:

1. Reading and approval of the minutes of the last meeting
2. Unfinished business
3. Reports of Officers
4. Reports of any standing committees
5. New business
6. Adjournment

B. Procedure from "Roberts' Rule of Order, Revised" shall be the final authority as to parliamentary procedure at all meetings of the member, insofar as they do not conflict with any provisions of the By-Laws.

C. Quorum: 25% of the membership shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Ladies Club.

ARTICLE V - LEADERSHIP

A. Officers

The members shall elect a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer to act as officers of the Ladies Club. The Vice President shall serve as the OGA Director (Representative).

B. Duties

President - Shall preside at all meetings of the Ladies Club, and shall have general supervision over the affairs of the club.

Vice President - Shall, in the absence of the President, perform her duties. Either the President or Vice President must be present for any meeting. She shall serve as liaison to OGA. If both are unavailable, said meeting shall be cancelled.

Secretary - Shall keep all records of meetings and perform other duties as may be assigned by the officers. Shall e-mail notices of meetings to the club members as provided by the By-Laws and conduct all correspondence, except that pertaining to the Treasurer.

Treasurer - Shall collect and discharge the funds as directed by the Ladies Club. She shall keep the accounting records belonging to the Ladies Club, and such books shall be open for inspection at all time. In the absence of the Treasurer, the President shall be empowered to sign checks in the name of the Ladies Club.

Executive Board - consists of the elected officers of the club. An Executive Board Session may be called as needed and appropriate for decisions on topics where general membership vote or Board of Directors vote is not required.

Board of Directors - consists of the officers and standing committee chairs. Decisions will be made by majority vote of the Board of Directors on matters that do not need to be referred to the General Membership.

ARTICLE VI - COMMITTEE CHAIRS

Committee Chairs shall be volunteer or appointed.

Award/ Trophies Chair - Shall be responsible for collecting all trophies and having them engraved before the closing meeting.

Day's Play Coordinator - Shall be responsible for each days play throughout the year, except for tournaments and other special events. Members will be advised by Day's Play Coordinators at the start of each organized play day as to the game of the day, and any pertinent information as to the rules of play (summer/winter rules, etc.). Day's play assistants will be responsible for collecting day's play fees and distributing payouts from prior play days.

Guest Day Chair - Shall coordinate our annual guest day assisted by volunteers to plan the day. Each member must invite one or more guests to participate in this fun event. The day includes lunch and prizes.

Guest Day Chair - Shall coordinate our annual guest day assisted by volunteers to plan the day. Each member shall invite one or more guests from another club to participate. The day includes lunch and prizes.

Handicap Chair - Shall assume responsibility for handicap revisions, maintaining records and notifying members of changes. Assist players with handicap cards. Provide opportunity for peer review and education. Correspond with OGA to keep both lists accurate.

Historian - Shall keep the history of the club in a designated book. Take pictures of members, competition winners, etc. Send to Web Manager for posting.

Home & Home Chair - Coordinates the interclub play between Stone Creek and other member clubs. Hostess rotates each year among participating clubs.

Interclub Play Captain (WIP)- Responsible for communication with OGA on this program and determines how team will be selected each month. Communicates with membership on the location, dates, times, and prices of each play day. Keeps club president informed on all policies regarding participation in this program.

Match Play Chair - Determines the number of flights and pairings for the event. Sets the entry fee and distribution of prize money.

Membership Chair - Updates application for membership and maintains current club roster. Coordinates with treasurer.

New Members Mentors - Mentors will play with new members for the first two rounds of play to guide new members through club policies and procedures.

OGA Representative - The Vice-President shall act as a liaison with Oregon Golf Association (OGA) and Ladies Club to inform Ladies Club of OGA activities. Coordinates with OGA and Ladies Club all OGA activities that have an impact on the Ladies Club.

Publication Chair - Prepare member handbook.

Rules Chair - Will assist members with any rules questions. She will consult with the club professionals if questions cannot be easily resolved.

Social Chair: Opening/Closing Day - Shall plan the social events for the club, specifically on opening day and closing day.

Competitions Chair: Spring, Fall and Club Championship Tournaments - Plan and conduct all competitions. Prepare schedule of events, and upon approval by the Board, distribute to members. Distribute responsibility of program among the committee members, and acquaint players with procedures. Publish and post conditions of competition. Assist in preparation of Local Rules, if any, to be used in play. Post World and Local Rules, and explain these rules to players.

Web Manager - Coordinates with the Pro Shop in the maintenance of the Ladies Club web site. Works with the Historian in posting pictures to the site.

Winter Eclectic (EC) Competition Chair - Coordinates sign-up and payment for participation in the out-of-season tournament. Sets rules and schedule of play. Maintains all records and awards prize money to the champions.

ARTICLE VII - TERMS OF OFFICE

Term of office shall be for one year. A standing officer may

run again.

ARTICLE VIII - ELECTIONS

At least five weeks prior to the Annual Meeting, the officers shall appoint a Nominating Committee. This committee shall submit names for nominations to each office, with permission from each nominee. These nominations will be presented at the closing meeting, with the President calling for any further nominations. If none appear, the President will close the nominations.

The vote may be taken by voice if only one candidate is nominated for each office. In the case of more than one candidate for any office, the vote will be by ballot. An election becomes final when the President announces the results of the voting, and all candidates agree to serve. New officers will assume office at the close of the meeting at which they are elected.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be repealed or amended, or new By-Laws adopted by a two-thirds majority of the members present at a regular meeting or at any special meeting held for that purpose.
