Treasurer – Kim Kolin

Kim announced that the club's financial resources will cover all tournament expenses; checking balance is \$3,005.42.

Committee Reports

Communications – Colleen Vedder

Colleen shared that she sends out the all-member communications that usually come from the president or Day's Play coordinators. Any all-member information is to be sent to her for distribution; may require board approval. Turn around time is same day or the next day. Member Planet program is used for all-member communications, as well as for messaging to groups of members signed up for specific events.

WIP (Women's Interclub Play) – Becky Schmidt and Tami Latham

WIP involves a team of SCWG members in match play tournament with other women's leagues. If interested include your name on the sign up sheet and the dates available to play. Monthly events are held with SCWG playing a different group at different courses from May – September, with a championship event held in October.

Day's Play Tuesday – Betsy Robertson

Betsy reviewed the sign-up process that begins with email from Rich Paden for members to indicate 'Playing'. In-season starting tee times 9am April and May, 8am in June-August and 9am in September-October. Arrive at the 1st tee box 15 minutes prior to tee time. SCWG uses GolfGenius to record everyone's score and to post for GHIN. If someone leaves the course before completing 18holes, leave unplayed holes blank (do not record as an X). Verify everyone's scores entered after completing the round. Max score is Par + 6 (Par 3s=9, Par 4s=10, Par 5s =11). The max score is for SCWG game payouts; GHIN will adjust your max for handicap posting based on your course handicap. Rich Paden, in Pro Shop, can answer questions about GolfGenius. Easy way to keep up with group ahead by first 2 players to hole out are to advance to the next tee box. This will help with pace of play. One person keeps GGID score for each hole, confirmed at the next tee box. Everyone keeps their own score card as well to confirm at the end of the round. Day's Play on Tuesdays include opportunities to record Chip Ins and Hole In 1s. See binder in restroom.

Day's Play Friday- Anita Harlan

Sign up for Friday Day's Play by 6pm two days prior. Fridays include a smaller group, therefore, we don't split the field by handicap. Game payouts include Net and \$1 for skins (low gross opportunity) and Par on all Par 3s.

Guest Day – Cindy Dolin

Guest day is on July 28, 2026 and includes an 8am shotgun start. The theme is Wicked for Golf. Friendly reminder that you need to have a guest and have another member with a guest to make your 4some. Or, you can have 3 guests to make your 4some. Basket donations are welcomed and cash donations are helpful for creating the whole tournament. Give donations to Cindy Dolin.

Eclectic Tournament – Nancy Welch

Ec includes your best score on every hole. Twenty-six members signed up for winter Ec and 21 actually played. Payouts were given for A, B and C flights including 3 lowest net, 3 lowest gross, along with overall low net and low gross. Winners announced for winter Ec and payouts given.

Ryder's Cup - Tami Latham

2026 will be the first Ryder Cup planned for Stone Creek vs Arrowhead with 20-24 golfers from each club competing. Event is scheduled for Thursday June 25, 2026. Format includes 9-hole 2-person best ball followed by 9-hole individual stroke play. Entry fee is \$65 which includes 18 holes of golf and a \$10 beverage voucher for use day-of event, Information sheets provided. Becky Schmidt will be the SCWG team captain. SCWG members interested in playing will be chosen to fill our roster through a lottery. All who are interested invited to submit their name on a ticket allowing those not in attendance to be included in the lottery.
