2:45pm President Lillian Cupparo opened the meeting that followed days-play.

Approval of Minutes from Member Meeting 4/7/26, minutes were approved electronically following the meeting.

Committee Reports

President – Lillian Cupparo reviewed Opening Day: 36 members attended, 50/50 raffle brought in \$500 generating payouts to 3 (\$83ea for total \$249) and raising \$251 for the club. Lillian is waiting on final accounting of costs to determine the final net earned. Lillian will check with the committee on how presentations from Puma and wine tasting were perceived, both member and commercial perspectives.

Hospitality – Cherie Siegmund Hospitality events will be scheduled with Sip & Visit events after day of golf. Lillian will check with Cherie on the schedule and the \$3 ticket value (i.e., is it a credit towards a drink or for a free beverage).

Membership – Colleen Vedder Currently, the club has 59 members.

Spring Competition – Kim Kolin Lillian received Kim's update and shared that the event is scheduled for next Tuesday May 5th, Waltz is the game format, and noted that the game buy-in for competition play days is \$10/person

Guest Day – Lillian Cupparo and Cindy Dolin Lillian reported that planning is ramping up and was excited to share that Cindy scored on a new battery push cart to be raffled off at the event; a special, Gold Ticket raffle. The course arrangements will accommodate 144 golfers. Members are to invite a guest to participate and can invite 3 guests to form their own foursome. Committee will investigate and report future planning for the Golden Ticket sale (e.g., # available, \$, online sales, etc.). Reminder from 4/7/26 member meeting notes: Guest day is on July 28, 2026 and includes an 8am shotgun start. The theme is Wicked for Golf. Basket donations are welcomed and cash donations are helpful for creating the whole tournament. Give donations to Cindy Dolin.

Aside suggestion: Is the SCWG interested in holding a 50/50 raffle at a men's group event? Interest expressed, arrangements to be investigated with course and men's group and brought back for future discussion.

Memorial Competition – Anita Harlan Scheduled for 5/26/26 shotgun start. This event is now part of planning under the Competition Committee; no longer a standalone committee. Anita asked for clarification on the event purpose. She agreed, as suggested, to talk with Nancy Welch about the origin of the event. A *true* memorial focus is envisioned with a sip and visit following golf when members will gather and reminisce about members "who have played through". Game fee for the day is \$10. The board approved changes to plaques displayed and to discontinue the perpetuity of a wall plaque for this event (12/16/25). Budget of \$100 for the event discussed with \$50 for game pool and \$50 for memorial bench plaques.

Kim Kolin to generate a notice for all members to participate in the Memorial Competition, including details about the game format, the sip & visit following, no charity donations planned, and winners recognized like other competitions and without a recognition plaque.
