

Stone Creek Women's Club Member Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, April 1, 2025

The President called the meeting to order at 8 am. The minutes from the last meeting were approved with no objections or changes.

Thank you to Lillian for putting on our Opening Day Breakfast and for introducing a 50/50 raffle event to be played at every member meeting.

The President reported that at present we have 54 members, down a few from last year so there were a few budget cuts. The Sip and Visit will no longer be funded by the club. We will still meet but you will purchase your own drinks.

Colleen reported that the Guest Day Committee met and put together guidelines for the event. The committee voted to allow all players to participate, including high and low handicappers. TREASURER REPORT
