

MEN'S CLUB BOARD MEETING MAY 28, 2019

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:

PRESIDENT REPORT:

Nothing to report.

VP REPORT:

Not present.

TREASURER REPORT:

No changes based on current membership projections.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE REPORT:

We are currently at 343 members with 40 being new members. 1 member who had a suspended handicap for failing to post scores has quit the club and currently there are 2 other members with suspended handicaps who are working towards reinstatement.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE REPORT:

Pleased with the turnout and overall success of the member/member guest tournament held on May25th.

Scheduled the red, white and blue tournament for Jun. 29th which will fall in between the next 2 majors. This has been approved by the pro shop and will support a field of 72 golfers.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chris presented a preliminary member survey questionnaire that was discussed in last month's meeting, and with a few minor changes, was agreed on by the board. The survey will be e-mailed to all club members. The board would appreciate a high volume of response from the membership so we can provide a better experience and encourage more participation in our major events.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was a mix up at the last major when a member, who was allowed to change his tee assignment based on his age and handicap, was assigned a different flight. A change of tees does not require a flight adjustment and this will be corrected going forward.

A suggestion was made to create a new member pamphlet to explain and clarify club activities such as the ringer and match play, for example.

A motion was made and passed to reduce the payouts on KPs from a floating amount of \$40 to \$50 per KP per flight (based on participation) to a fixed amount of \$30 and add that money to the tournament payout.

There were a few suggestions for men's club events going forward. First make sure ALL the pairings are random. Also, allow for a selection of tee times (early, mid and late) on all signups. Currently some do while some don't. Finally, it would be easier if flights were labeled as A, B and C or 1,2 and 3 instead of a formal name. It seems confusing to some members as to which flight there are in, for example when selecting the correct KP marker.
