PRESIDENT REPORT:

Received compliments from some club members on improved communication by the club, specifically the schedule released for the Wed. men's club game listing the formats for the remainder of the year.

VP REPORT:

TREASURER REPORT:

Currently budgeted for the rest of the year with approximately \$1000 carryover at year's end. That includes the funding of the remaining tournaments at \$360 each. The budget also provides for the meals and turkeys for the Turkey Shoot as well as a minimum of \$500 for door prizes.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE REPORT:

We are holding steady at 350 members with 41 being new members.

Will attend a training class on Oct. 8 with OGA on the new handicap system that is to be implemented next year. This system will be discussed at our annual meeting after the Turkey Shoot

Modified a member's handicap due to 2 extremely low net scores in a recent tournament. Also, will be stricter in future on scores being posted within 24 hours after completion of a round.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE REPORT:

Submitted the schedule of preferred dates for the 2020 men's club tournaments to the golf course. We are awaiting their response which should come no later than Nov.

Announced the format for the upcoming President Cup to be the Stableford scoring system.

OLD BUSINESS:

The club's by-laws have been revised and accepted by the board. The current version is posted in the men's club section on the Stone Creek website. The revisions to the member handbook are close to completion and will be online shortly.

NEW BUSINESS:

The time clocks recently purchased by the club to monitor slow play will be used only to gather data for the rest of the current year. Starting with the season opener next year, the Time Par Standard will take effect. The Time Par Standard deals with slow play and is explained in the amended version of the member handbook to be available online soon.

Pat Walsh has volunteered to fill the remaining term of the at large board position which was vacated by Chris Underwood. The board, by a unanimous vote, appointed Pat to fill the vacated position.
